As part of a young and dynamic team, you will support the implementation of regular breeding work and various applied research projects, including participatory testing of grain legumes on farms in Switzerland, nitrogen fixation and investigating the suitability of different agricultural species for intercropping. Your internship will include the following tasks:

- regular work in the breeding program
- collection, evaluation and analysis of field data
- planning, preparation and maintenance of agricultural field trials
- support in post-harvest seed management
- implementation and communication of projects

In addition to an open personality and the competence to take responsibility and plan and implement subprojects independently, we look forward to the following qualifications:

- interest in the topics of plant breeding, biodiversity and agriculture
- Motivation for practical field work and theoretical discussions -
- ongoing or completed studies in agriculture, biology, environmental sciences or equivalent qualification with relevant work experience
- very good knowledge of at least two of the languages English, German, French
- basic knowledge of statistics and willingness to deal with digital data management and statistical analysis
- driving license category B
